## **RULES**:

- 1. Open to Professionals, Non-Professionals and Children (up to the age of 18) and will be shown and judged separately.
- 2. Children 11 and under are exempt from purchasing an exhibitor's ticket if the child's parent, grandparent or legal guardian has purchased a Membership, Season and Mini Ticket for entering. Pre-registration is necessary for children as well as adults.
- 3. Any Art item that received a place ribbon last year in any category may not be entered for one year.
- 4. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE FRAMED AND WIRED FOR HANGING - NO DUCT TAPED/TAPED WIRING. A: ABSOLUTLY NO BLACK PLASTIC POP IN FRAMES.

**B**: Watercolors, pastels, charcoals, pencils MUST BE UNDER GLASS and follow framing rules.

**C:** NO saw tooth hangers allowed.
